Uploading SAIN3_Nature_Green-x.x.x.tgz

Before you begin the installation process, we recommend to backup your Magento installation and database.

1. Go to system->Magento Connect ->Magento Connect Manager

When you get a extension key, paste the key to install.

When you get a package file, upload the package.

Copy all files / folders from folder "SAIN3_Nature_Green--x.x.x.tgz" to your Magento root directory, If you are using make please makes sure you are merging and not replacing Magento directory.

Section 1: Theme of Website Installation & Configuration

Step One: Magento Admin Panel Configuration

Make “Nature Green” your theme

Login to the Magento Admin Panel

Go To: 'System → Configuration' Click on “Design” on the left menu

- » Under Themes Tab put “green” into 'Templates', 'Skin' , 'Layout' Field(click [here](#) to view more)
- » Under Header Tab put “images/logo.gif” into 'Logo image Src' Field
- » You can also enter the Image alter text and Default Welcome Text

Scroll back to the top of the page and click the Save Config button

Next, go to 'System > Cache Management' from the top navigation menu. You will need to clear the store cache and all cookies.

Click the following buttons (in orange): Flush Magento Cache, Flush Cache Storage, Flush JavaScript/CSS Cache, and Flush Catalog Images Cache (optional). Now you are ready to add content to your website.

How to enable a theme for Magento mobile web site?

In order to use one theme for a Magento web site when it is loaded through a personal computer and a different one for mobile devices follow the steps listed below.

Do NOT enter its name in the Default theme field. This way the default theme will be loaded when the web site is opened through a computer.

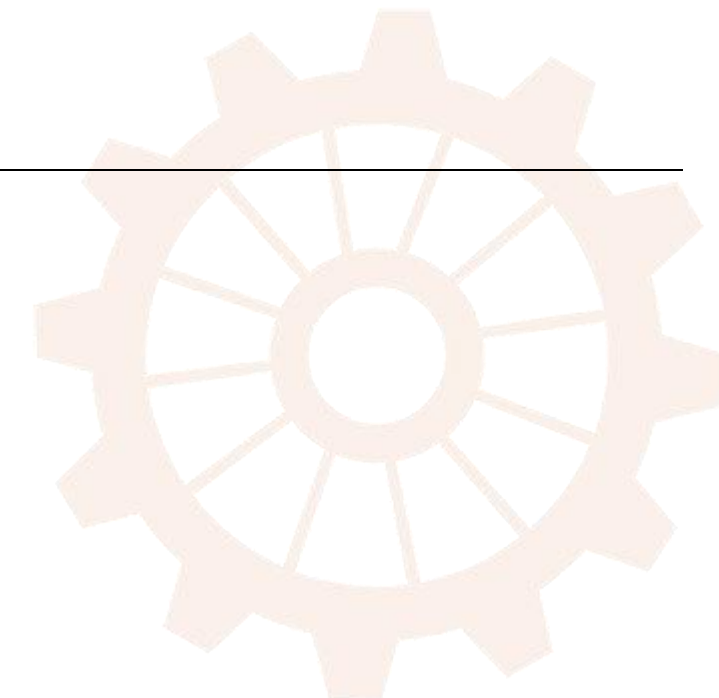
Next you should add exceptions for the mobile devices. Navigate to the Magento administrative area -> System -> Configuration -> Design -> Themes. Click on the Add Exceptions buttons besides the Templates, Skin and Layout labels.

Enter the following line in the Matched Expression field:

`iPhone|iPod|BlackBerry|Palm|Googlebot-Mobile|Mobile|mobile|mobi|Windows Mobile|Safari Mobile|Android|Opera Mini`

In the Value field enter “`green`” and Save the changes.

Then you can open your web site through your computer and your mobile phone. You will see that it loads with two different themes depending on the device.



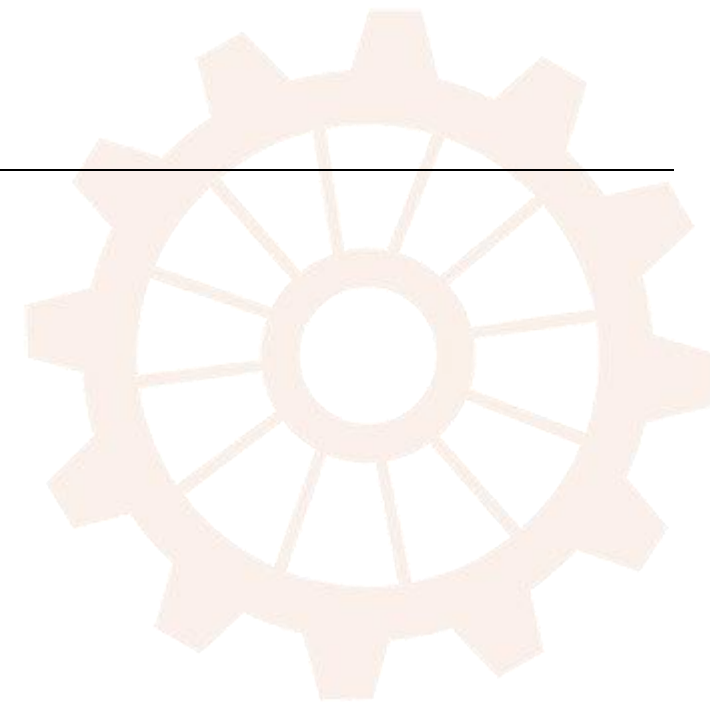



Troubleshooting & Support

1. I'm getting 404 not found when trying to open theme admin pages.

Log out from Magento admin panel, clear the store cache under var/cache, and log in again.

2. After the extension installation the store gives an error, or blank page. Log out from Magento admin panel.

Change the owner of the extracted extension files to the web server user and set 775 permissions on them. Clear the store cache and try again.

3. My configuration changes do not appear on the frontend.

Clear the store cache under var/cache, clear all browser cookies for your store domain and refresh the page in your browser.
